### 1. Recommendation

## 2. Observations

The application relates to Rhodia Limited (chemical industrial premises) located on Trinity Street, Oldbury.

The proposal is for the demolition of a tin shop and Keg Shop. Both of these buildings would be removed by mechanical means. Dust emanating from the demolition would be suppressed by water. In the short term the slab level would be retained.

The applicants have provided a detailed 'method of demolition statement' which makes significant provision for health and safety.

I consider the proposed means of demolition is suitable and given the location of the buildings to be demolished which are well within the site it is unlikely that it would result in any significant harm to public amenity.

On the basis of the above I recommend demolition approval.
