Planning permission for the above captioned works was granted on 05 September 2005. Our client, Mintworth Transport Ltd intends to commence this work in February 2006. This letter addresses conditions on the planning that were required to be addressed before commencement of the works.

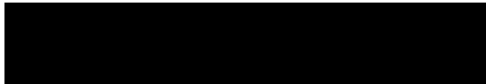
Condition	Comment
3	Location and Treatment of Mineshafts. It is intended that this work will be implemented following completion of infilling. A detailed specification for this work will be prepared and submitted to the Coal Authority for permission prior to implementation of the works. A summary method statement is, however, attached to this letter (Attachment A).
4	An outline method statement was included in the documentation in support of the planning application. A more detailed method statement is attached (Attachment B).
5	The attached method statement includes details of the proposed methodology for handling any displaced water from the lagoon, including settlement lagoons.
6	It is intended to infill the lagoon using clean crushed rocksand. The attached method statement includes details of the proposed testing regime that will be implemented to ensure that only inert non waste materials are used.
7	These items are addressed in the attached method statement.

15 to 17	Details of proposed parking arrangements are shown on the plan that accompanies the attached method statement
