Please find enclosed recently issued Hazardous Substances Consent.


As discussed I believe that condition 2 is an error and should read:

“The storage of methylene bis (thiocyanate) and 2 – [(thiocyanatomethyl) thio] – benzothiazole shall be restricted to the Poly Phosphoric Acid Building”.

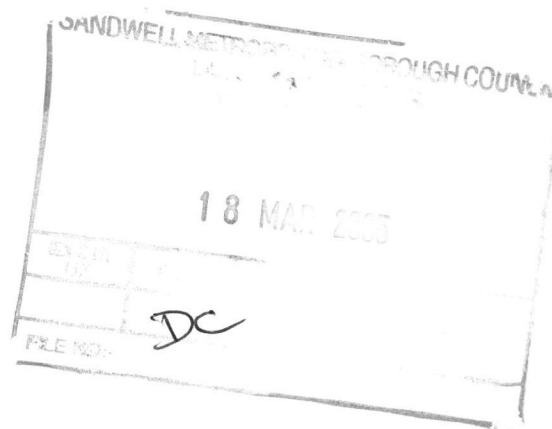
We agreed during a visit by the HSE in 2004 that these two substances would be stored only in this building (due to their fire hazard). We made plain during the visit that the other two substances covered in the HSC (THPC and THPS) could be stored anywhere on site. Both THPC and THPS are aqueous solutions and do not present a fire hazard. The HSE were happy with this stance.
